U.S. HIGHWAY 101 GOLETA DRAINAGE PROJECT FINAL PAVING

GOLETA – The final paving before completion of the Goleta Drainage Project will take place for three nights beginning Monday, May 16. Motorists will encounter lane and ramp closures in both directions of US Highway near Fairview Avenue from 8 pm until 6 am.

In addition, paving will take place on Calle Real between Carlo Drive and Valdez Avenue for three nights during the overnight hours beginning Monday, May 16 between 8 pm until 6 am. One lane will remain open all times during this roadwork.

The contractor for this \$17 million project is Flatiron West Incorporated of San Marcos, CA. This project is expected to be completed later this month.

This project will improve the capacity of two drainage culverts along Las Vegas Creek and San Pedro Creek west of Fairview Avenue. Caltrans, the Santa Barbara County Flood Control District and City of Goleta worked cooperatively on this project.

All local businesses in the Fairview Shopping Center remain open for business during the project.
