## **U.S. HIGHWAY 101 OVERNIGHT RAMP CLOSURES NEAR GOLETA THIS WEEK FOR RESURFACING**

SANTA BARBARA COUNTY – Motorists can expect to encounter intermittent overnight ramp closures in both directions of US Highway 101 between Patterson Avenue and Cathedral Oaks Road for the next two weeks Sunday night through Friday morning from **9 pm until 6 am**. This schedule will be in effect beginning Monday, May 23, at 9 pm until Friday, June 3 at 6 am. The No. 2 lane on surface streets nearest to these ramps will also be closed during these hours.

**No two consecutive ramps will be closed at any time during this roadwork.**

The resurfacing of the travel lanes of US 101 from north of Cathedral Oaks Road to north of Turnpike Road will resume as soon as overnight low temperatures are suitable for paving.

The contractor for this \$9.4 million project is Granite Construction of Santa Barbara, CA. This project is expected to be completed this summer.
