TWO DAY CHIP SEAL PROJECT ON STATE ROUTES 192/144 BEGINS WEDNESDAY, JULY 8

SANTA BARBARA – A two day chip seal project on State Routes 192/144 will begin on Wednesday, July 8. Motorists can expect one-way reversing traffic control in the following locations from **8 am until 4 pm**:

- State Route 144 from Alameda Padre Serra to the Junction of State Route 144/192.
- State Route 192 from Mission Canyon Road East to the 700 Block of Mountain Drive.
- State Route 192 from Stanwood Drive to Orizaba Road.

Motorists can expect delays not to exceed 10 minutes. This chip seal project is designed to prolong the life of the roadway.

This road work will be performed by the Caltrans Maintenance team in Santa Barbara.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway construction zones.
