HIGHWAY MAINTENANCE/RESURFACING ON U.S. HIGHWAY 101 IN GOLETA THIS WEEK

SANTA BARBARA COUNTY – A project to preserve the pavement of US Highway 101 in Goleta will take place this week during the overnight hours in the following locations:

- The No. 3 (right) lane of northbound US Highway 101 near Fairview Avenue will be closed on Tuesday, Oct. 18 from 8 pm until 6 am for resurfacing and the installation of temporary delineators.
- The northbound lanes of US Highway 101 near Fairview Avenue will be closed on an alternating basis on Wednesday, Oct. 19 from 8 pm until 6 am for striping.
- The southbound lanes of US Highway 101 near Fairview Avenue will be closed on an alternating basis on Thursday, Oct. 20 from 8 pm until 6 am for striping.

The resurfacing of US Highway 101 from Cathedral Oaks Road to Turnpike Road continues with alternating lane closures in both directions between Patterson Avenue and Winchester Canyon Road Sunday night through Friday morning during the overnight hours between 7 pm until 7 am with delays not to exceed 15 minutes. The contractor for this \$9.4 million project is Granite Construction of Santa Barbara, CA. This project is expected to be complete this fall.
