U.S. HIGHWAY 101 OVERNIGHT LANE/RAMP CLOSURES NEAR GOLETA CONTINUE

SANTA BARBARA COUNTY – A project to resurface US Highway 101 from north of Cathedral Oaks Road to north of Turnpike Road will result in the following lane/ramp closures during the week of Monday, Aug. 8.

- Alternating lane closures on southbound US Highway 101 from Winchester Canyon Road to Fairview Avenue on Aug. 8 and 9 during **overnight hours from 6 pm until 6:30 am** and on Wednesday, Aug. 10 and 11 from 8 pm until 6:30 am.
- The southbound on-ramps to US Highway 101 at Patterson Avenue, Winchester Canyon Road and Los Carneros Road will be closed intermittently during **overnight hours from 8 pm until 6:30 am**. No two consecutive ramps will be closed.

Construction on this resurfacing project will continue each week from Sunday night through Friday morning during overnight hours with traffic delays not to exceed 15 minutes.

The contractor for this \$9.4 million project is Granite Construction of Santa Barbara, CA. It is scheduled to be complete by mid-November.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
