HIGHWAY 1 SLIDE DEBRIS REMOVAL NEAR DAVENPORT BEGINS MONDAY

SANTA CRUZ COUNTY – A one-mile section of Highway 1 near Davenport from ½ mile south of to 1 ½ miles north of Waddell Creek Bridge will undergo slide debris removal beginning Monday, October 29, Caltrans officials have announced.

This roadwork will include one-way reversing traffic control with a pilot car or flaggers Monday through Thursday from 8 am to 4 pm and Friday from 8 am to 3 pm. Up to 20-minute delays can be anticipated.

Work consists of annual removal of slide debris that accumulates from December to October each year. Roadwork is expected to be completed by the end of January, 2013, weather permitting.

The contractor for this \$178,000 project is John Madonna Construction, Co. Inc. of San Luis Obispo, CA.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over or slow down when driving through Caltrans work zones.
