## **ONE DAY CHIP SEAL PROJECT ON HIGHWAY 9 AND HIGHWAY 236 NEAR WATERMAN'S GAP NORTH OF BOULDER CREEK BEGINS THURSDAY, JULY 9**

SANTA CRUZ COUNTY – A one-day chip seal project between the north junction of Highways 9 and 236 (Waterman's Gap) and continue north for two miles, 7½ miles north of the town of Boulder Creek and 4½ miles south of the junction of Hwy 9 and 35 (Saratoga Gap), will take place on Thursday, July 9 from 8 am until 7 pm.

Motorists will encounter one-way reversing traffic control with flaggers during this project to improve the surface of the roadway.

Message signs will be posted to inform the public about this ect. The CHP will be present to assist with traffic control. Motorists can expect a delay not to exceed 15 minutes.

This project is being performed by Caltrans Maintenance crews in Santa Cruz County.
