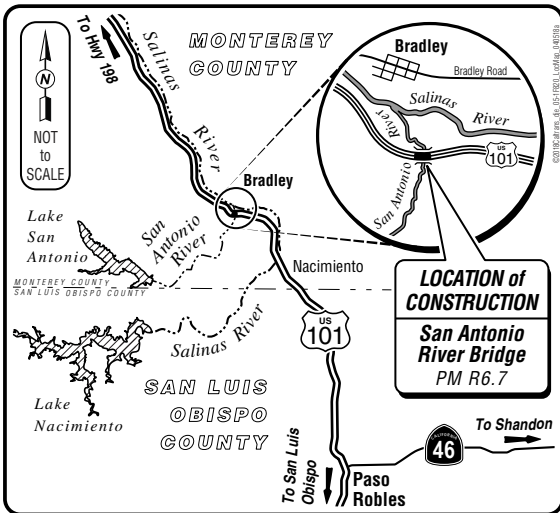
PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

If there are no major comments or requests for a public hearing prior to the deadline, Caltrans will proceed with the project's design.

What Is Being Planned?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes the seismic retrofit of two State Route 101 bridge structures at the San Antonio River in Monterey County, approximately one mile south of the town of Bradley. The project proposes to strengthen the bridges (44-0141L/44-0141R) to better withstand a future seismic event.



Why This Public Notice?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show it will not affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why is called an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration. This notice is to tell you of the preparation of the Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration and of its availability for you to read, and to offer the opportunity for public review and comment.
