MISSION CANYON PROJECT ON STATE ROUTE 192 TO RESUME TOMORROW

SANTA BARBARA – The Mission Canyon Safety Project on State Route 192 (Foothill Road) will resume on Tuesday, May 12 with work beginning on a new retaining wall.

A full closure of State Route 192, near 2811 Foothill Road will resume on Wednesday, May 13 between Cheltenham Road and Tye Road.

Fire crews continue to have full access to the project area in an emergency.

Motorists may detour by using Mission Canyon Road, Los Olivos Street, Garden Street, Constance Avenue, State Street and Alamar Avenue.

This project located between Glen Albyn Drive and Mission Canyon Road will result in drainage improvements and a widening and paving of the shoulders.

The contractor for this \$1.7 million project is R. Burke Construction of San Luis Obispo, CA. This project is expected to be complete by August of this year.
