



**SR-710 Tunnel Technical Study
Exploration Program Notice
TUESDAY, MARCH 24, 2009**

In June 2008, Caltrans and Metro began the SR-710 Tunnel Technical Study to examine all reasonable and practical alternatives for extending the SR-710 using a tunnel. This geotechnical study will involve research, exploration and technical analysis of the soil and sub-surface conditions found while tunneling at depths of more than 250 feet.

What type of testing will be performed?	Testing of local soils will be studied by drilling (boring) a six- inch wide hole through the soil surface. Information about the various types of soil, such as rock or sand, will be gathered.
Where is the testing site located?	The testing site is located on Arroyo Dr., between Mission St and Hawthorne St. in the <u>City of South Pasadena.</u>
*When will testing in my area begin and end?	Work will begin on Tuesday, March 24, 2009 and continue through Friday April 3, 2009.
*What time will testing crews be present?	Crews will be on-site from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. <u>Security personnel will be on site from 5 p.m. to 8 a.m.</u>
What can I expect during working hours?	Intermittent drilling noise, dust and slight traffic delays. No parking will be permitted in the boring site.
Will local access be permitted during the testing?	Access to private property will be maintained at all times. No traffic detours are planned. Please follow all applicable traffic and safety laws.
