Closures on the Foothill Freeway (Interstate 210)

Glendale, La Cañada Flintridge and Pasadena - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Foothill Freeway (I-210) as part of a pavement rehabilitation project. Residents and local businesses located near the freeway may notice noise, vibrations and dust associated with construction activities. Noise levels will not exceed state and federal regulations. Water trucks will be used to minimize dust during working hours. The following schedule will be in effect, weather permitting, and is subject to change:

Saturday Night, January 23

Eastbound I-210

- 12:01 a.m. to 7 a.m. – Up to 4 lanes between Angeles Crest Highway (SR-2) and Lake Avenue

Westbound I-210

- 12:01 a.m. to 7 a.m. – Up to 4 lanes between Lake Avenue and Angeles Crest Highway (SR-2)

Nightly, Monday, January 25 through Thursday, January 28

Eastbound I-210

- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to 3 lanes between Lowell Avenue and Lake Avenue
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to 2 lanes of eastbound I-210 connector to SR-710/SR-134

Westbound I-210

- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to 3 lanes between Lowell Avenue and SR-710/SR-134

The night time closures are necessary to minimize traffic delays and provide a safe work zone for construction crews and motorists while working along the I-210. Flatiron West, Inc. is the contractor on this \$148.5 million project. Construction signs and changeable message signs will be in place to alert motorists to construction activities and closures. Motorists should anticipate delays, plan ahead and use alternate routes. Caltrans appreciates your patience while we work to improve I-210. Motorists are advised to **“Be Work Zone Alert.”**
