U.S HIGHWAY 101 LA CONCHITA PEDESTRIAN UNDERCROSSING AND BIKE PATH INAUGURATION

WHAT: The California Department of Transportation, Ventura County Transportation Commission and Santa Barbara Council of Governments will hold a ribbon-cutting ceremony for the U.S. Highway 101 La Conchita Pedestrian Undercrossing (PUC) and Class I Bike Path, elements of the six-mile carpool lane project between Mobil Pier Road in Ventura County and Casitas Pass Road in Santa Barbara County.

WHEN: Monday, September 29, 10 a.m.

WHERE: La Conchita (on the beach side of US 101), where the PUC Ramp and Bike Path meet

- Use the PUC to walk to the beach from La Conchita
- Turn right when you exit the tunnel

DIRECTIONS:

Northbound U.S. 101:

Exit Santa Barbara Avenue in La Conchita after Seacliff and before Bates Road.

Southbound U.S. 101:

Exit Seacliff and turn left to access Northbound U.S. 101 to Santa Barbara Avenue.
