## **Intermittent Sepulveda Boulevard Lane Closures Scheduled**

**Los Angeles** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close up to two lanes of Sepulveda Boulevard between Greenleaf Avenue and Dickens Street in both directions intermittently during daytime hours for approximately three weeks beginning on Tuesday, May 9. Northbound and southbound lanes will not be closed at the same time.

The closures are part of a \$46 million improvement project at the 101/405 Interchange extending the current auxiliary lane on northbound I-405 past the Greenleaf off-ramp to the U.S. 101 connector, permanently closing the loop on-ramp from eastbound Ventura Boulevard and constructing the Dickens Street bypass. The project is estimated to complete in spring 2007.
