## CALTRANS COMMUTER ALERT TRAFFIC CONTROL SCHEDULED FOR BIKE RACE

**VENTURA AND LOS ANGELES COUNTIES** - Traffic control (rolling lane closures with delays for motorists) will be in effect on various state routes and freeways from San Francisco to Santa Monica this week for the Golden State Challenge/Ride 2 Recovery bicycle ride.

The sixth portion of the race is scheduled for Friday, October 26 between approximately 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. and will proceed from Santa Barbara County to Ventura County. Race participants will enter US 101 at Bailard Avenue traveling southbound to Seacliff. They will then proceed southbound on Pacific Coast Highway (SR-1) to Main Street.

The final portion of the race is scheduled for Saturday, October 27 between approximately 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. and will proceed from Ventura County to Santa Monica. Race participants will enter SR-1 at Las Posas Road and travel southbound on SR-1 to the Santa Monica Pier.
