CULVER BOULEVARD CLOSURE SCHEDULED

CULVER CITY – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close Culver Boulevard in both directions between Sawtelle Boulevard and Sepulveda Boulevard from 10 p.m. Friday, April 4 until 6 a.m. Saturday, April 5.

All appropriate signs and detours will be posted and access for residents and emergency vehicles will be provided.

The work is related to a \$167 million High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV, or carpool) lanes project on I-405 between the Marina Freeway (Route 90) and I-10. The project is expected to complete summer 2009, at which time the HOV lane on southbound I-405 will be continuous from the San Fernando Valley through Orange County.

An HOV lane project on northbound I-405 from I-10 to the Ventura Freeway (U.S. 101) is currently in the environmental phase and is expected to begin construction in 2009. When that project is completed, in 2013, the HOV lane will be continuous in both directions from the San Fernando Valley through Orange County.
