I-5 HOV Improvements

(SR-134 to Magnolia Boulevard)

Caltrans is building a high occupancy vehicle (HOV or carpool) lane in each direction of the Golden State Freeway (I-5) between the Ventura Freeway (SR-134) and Magnolia Boulevard in Burbank. The new HOV lane requires removal and replacement of the existing soundwall. This work is now underway.

During construction, we recommend that you secure your pets. Please be sure to move furniture or other items away from the work area.

This project is building a high occupancy vehicle lane (also known as a carpool lane) in each direction along the Golden State Freeway (I-5) between the Ventura Freeway (SR-134) and Magnolia Boulevard in Burbank. In addition, the new soundwalls are currently underway. The project will alleviate congestion, encourage carpooling, improve air quality, reduce noise and reduce traffic on city streets. Work began in March 2011. Anticipated completion is late 2014.
