CALTRANS COMMUTER ALERT TRAFFIC CONTROL SCHEDULED FOR BIKE RACE

LOS ANGELES COUNTY - Rolling lane closures (traffic control) will be in effect on various state routes and freeways, Friday, May 21 through Sunday, May 23, for the "AMGEN Tour of California" a multi-day, statewide professional bicycle race.

On Friday, May 21, the north and southbound off-ramps of the Antelope Valley Highway (SR-14) to Sierra Highway will be closed from 9:40 a.m. to 9:50 a.m., followed by traffic control at the intersection of Upper Big Tujunga Road and the Angeles Crest Highway (SR-2).

On Saturday, May 22, from noon to 5 p.m. traffic control will be in place at the following off-ramps:

- Southbound Harbor Freeway (I-110) from Exposition Boulevard to 23rd Street.
- Southbound Hollywood Freeway (US 101) at Broadway
- Northbound US 101 at Adams Street

On Sunday, May 23 from noon to 4 p.m. traffic control will be in place at the following off-ramps:

- Southbound US 101 to Westlake Blvd (SR-23)
- Northbound US 101 to SR-23
- Southbound SR-23 between Agoura Road. and Townsgate Rd.
- SR-23 between Agoura Rd, and Mullholland Road
