Maintenance Closure on Pacific Coast Highway (SR-1)

SANTA MONICA – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close one lane of the southbound Pacific Coast Highway (SR-1) to clear storm drains of mud, sand, and gravel. Work will occur Tuesday, December 6 and Wednesday, December 7 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. between California Incline and the Santa Monica Pier. Delays could occur.

Apparently, concrete was poured into the storm drains by an unknown entity. A Caltrans storm water robot camera crew will inspect the drains after they are cleared to assess the extent of damage. A contractor will be hired to clear the concrete.
