## **RAMP AND LANE CLOSURES FOR THE 2010 TOURNAMENT OF ROSES PARADE**

**Pasadena** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces the following scheduled closures for the 2010 Tournament of Roses Parade:

**Thursday, December 31, 2009 to Friday, January 1, 2010**

### **Glendale Freeway (SR-134)**

- 8 p.m. to 11 a.m. – Eastbound Orange Grove Boulevard off-ramp.
- 2 a.m. to 12 p.m. – Westbound Orange Grove Boulevard on-ramp.

### **Long Beach Freeway (SR- 710)**

- 8 p.m. to 12 p.m. – Southbound Del Mar Boulevard off-ramp.
- 8 p.m. to 10 a.m. – Northbound Del Mar Boulevard on-ramp.
- 8 p.m. to 10 a.m. – Northbound California Boulevard on-ramp.

### **Pasadena Avenue**

- 8 p.m. to 10 a.m. – **All** lanes of Pasadena Avenue from Columbia Street to Del Mar Boulevard.

### **Foothill Freeway (I-210)**

**Thursday, December 31 to Friday, January 1, 2010**

- 8 p.m. to 4 p.m. – East- and westbound Sierra Madre Boulevard off-ramps.

**Saturday, January 2 and Sunday, January 3, 2010**

- 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. – East- and westbound Sierra Madre Boulevard off-ramps.

An encroachment permit has been issued for these event-related closures.

Beginning January 1, the “Move Over/Slow Down” law goes into effect stating that motorists must move over one lane, if safe to do so, or slow down when vehicles with flashing amber lights are active on the side of the road. The law is for the safety and protection of Caltrans road workers, law enforcement personnel, tow truck operators and emergency responders who are working roadside.
