## PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY (SR-1) ROCKSLIDE CLOSURE

**Point Mugu, Ventura County** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) closure of a nine-mile section of Pacific Coast Highway (SR-1) in both directions from Yerba Buena Road to Las Posas Road, due to rockslides, is expected to be lifted at 6 a.m. on Tuesday, December 28. The opening of the highway and repair work could be delayed by additional rains.

Motorists should plan for delays as flagging operations will be in place as crews continue to remove debris from the area during the daytime. The northbound lane will be closed from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. and at night the lane will be open from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Climbers are removing loose debris from the hillside that could eventually fall onto the highway.

The closure began Saturday night, December 18 when rocks began to fall onto the highway due to heavy rains.

Motorists are advised to plan ahead and consider alternate routes around this area.
