## **POMONA FREEWAY (SR-60) CLOSURE SCHEDULE**

**CITY OF INDUSTRY** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces the following lane and ramp closures for the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV or carpool) lane construction and pavement replacement project on the Pomona Freeway (SR-60) between the San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605) and Orange Freeway (SR-57). At least one lane will remain open to traffic in each direction at all times. Ramp closures will be staged so that no two consecutive ramps are closed at the same time. The following overnight closure schedule will be in effect, weather permitting:

### **Eastbound SR-60**

#### **Nightly, Sunday, August 12, 2007 through Thursday, August 16, 2007**

- 10 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Up to three lanes between Azusa Avenue and Fullerton Road.

#### **Sunday, August 12, 2007 and Monday, August 13, 2007**

- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Azusa Avenue on-ramps.
- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Fullerton Road off-ramp.

#### **Sunday, August 12, 2007 through Tuesday, August 14, 2007**

7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Fullerton Road on-ramps.

#### **Tuesday, August 14, 2007**

- 11 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Nogales Street off-ramp.

#### **Wednesday, August 15, 2007**

- 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Fairway Drive off-ramp.
- 6 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Nogales Street on-ramps.

#### **Thursday, August 16, 2007**

- 7 p.m. until 7 a.m. – Brea Canyon Road on- and off-ramps.
- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Fairway Drive on-ramps.

### **Westbound SR-60**

#### **Nightly, Sunday, August 12, 2007 and Thursday, August 16, 2007**

- 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Hacienda Boulevard on-ramps.

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## POMONA FREEWAY (SR-60) CLOSURE SCHEDULE

- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue off-ramp.

SR-60 is one of the most heavily traveled freeways and a main truck route to and from the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach. The addition of carpool lanes will alleviate congestion on this route. As part of this project, Caltrans will construct soundwalls to minimize freeway noise, upgrade and reconfigure on- and off-ramps as needed. Completion of the project is estimated for fall 2010. Skanska USA is the project contractor on this \$125 million project. Caltrans advises motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”

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
