POMONA FREEWAY (SR-60) CLOSURE SCHEDULE

Los Angeles - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces the following lane and ramp closures for the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV or carpool) lane construction and pavement replacement project on the Pomona Freeway (SR-60) between the San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605) and Orange Freeway (SR-57). At least one lane will remain open to traffic in each direction at all times. Ramp closures will be staged so that no two consecutive ramps are closed at the same time. The following overnight closure schedule will be in effect, weather permitting:

Eastbound SR-60

Nightly, Monday, August 6, 2007 and Thursday August 8, 2007

- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – 7th Avenue off-ramps.

Tuesday, August 7, 2007

- 9 p.m. until 7 a.m. – Up to three lanes between Hacienda Boulevard and Nogales Street.
- 11 p.m. until 6 a.m. - Azusa Avenue off-ramp.

Wednesday, August 8, 2007

- 6 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Nogales Street on-ramps.

Westbound SR-60

Monday, August 6, 2007

- 10 p.m. until a.m. – Azusa Avenue on-ramps.
- 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Up to two lanes between Azusa Avenue and Hacienda Boulevard.
- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Crossroads Parkway off-ramp.

Tuesday, August 7, 2007

- 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Up to two lanes between 7th Avenue and Crossroads Parkway.
- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – 7th Avenue on- and off-ramps.

POMONA FREEWAY (SR-60) CLOSURE SCHEDULE

Wednesday, August 8, 2007

- 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Up to two lanes between Hacienda boulevard and 7th Avenue.
- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – 7th Avenue off-ramp.
- 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Hacienda Boulevard on-ramp.

Wednesday, August 8, 2007 and Thursday, August 9, 2007

- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – 7th Avenue off-ramp.

SR-60 is one of the most heavily traveled freeways and a main truck route to and from the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach. The addition of carpool lanes will alleviate congestion on this route. As part of this project, Caltrans will construct soundwalls to minimize freeway noise, upgrade and reconfigure on- and off-ramps as needed. Completion of the project is estimated for fall 2010. Skanska USA is the project contractor on this \$125 million project. Caltrans advises motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”

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
