## **POMONA FREEWAY (SR-60) CLOSURE SCHEDULE**

**CITY OF INDUSTRY** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces the following lane and ramp closures for the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV or carpool) lane construction and pavement replacement project on the Pomona Freeway (SR-60) between the San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605) and Orange Freeway (SR-57). At least one lane will remain open to traffic in each direction at all times. Ramp closures will be staged so that no two consecutive ramps are closed at the same time. The following overnight closure schedule will be in effect, weather permitting:

### **Eastbound SR-60**

#### **Nightly, Monday September 24 through Friday, September 28**

- 9 p.m. until 7 a.m. – Up to four lanes between Crossroads Parkway and Nogales Street.
- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue on- and off-ramps.
- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Crossroads Parkway on- and off-ramps.
- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue on- and off-ramps.
- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Hacienda Boulevard on- and off-ramps.
- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Azusa Avenue on- and off-ramps.
- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Fullerton Road on- and off-ramps.
- 11 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Nogales Street off-ramp.

### **Westbound SR-60**

#### **Nightly, Monday, September 24 through Friday, September 28**

- 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Up to four lanes between Azusa Avenue and Crossroads Parkway.
- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Crossroads Parkway on- and off-ramps.
- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue on- and off-ramps.
- 7 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Hacienda Boulevard on- and off-ramps.
- 10 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Azusa on- and off-ramps.

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## POMONA FREEWAY (SR-60) CLOSURE SCHEDULE

SR-60 is one of the most heavily traveled freeways and a main truck route to and from the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach. The addition of carpool lanes will alleviate congestion on this route. As part of this project, Caltrans will construct soundwalls to minimize freeway noise, upgrade and reconfigure on- and off-ramps as needed. Completion of the project is estimated for fall 2010. Skanska USA is the project contractor on this \$125 million project. Caltrans advises motorists to **“Slow For The Cone Zone.”**

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
