SR-134 – NEW HOLLYWOOD WAY ON-RAMP – UPDATE #2

VENTURA FREEWAY (SR-134) RAMP CLOSURES FOR NEW HOLLYWOOD WAY RAMP CONSTRUCTION

Burbank – As part of bridge work for construction of a new on-ramp to the westbound Ventura Freeway (State Route 134) at Hollywood Way, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces the following ramp closures:

- Nightly beginning Monday, May 7 through Friday, May 11 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.:
The westbound Ventura Freeway (SR-134) off-ramp to Hollywood Way
- Nightly beginning Monday, May 7 through Friday, May 11 from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.:
The Alameda Avenue on-ramp to the westbound Ventura Freeway (SR-134)

These closures are weather-permitting and subject to change. Signs and detours will be posted to assist motorists.

Caltrans thanks the motoring public and residents of Burbank, Toluca Lake and North Hollywood for their patience and cooperation during these transportation improvement projects. This freeway improvement project will enhance safety, relieve congestion and improve mobility and access to and from SR-134 and the Media District.
