SAN BERNARDINO FREEWAY (I-10) RESTORATION LANE CLOSURES

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of I-10 for pavement work. One lane will remain open to traffic at all times; no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Closures are as follows, weather permitting.

I-10

- 10 p.m. Monday, November 30 through 5 a.m. Thursday, December 3 – The High occupancy vehicle (HOV or carpool) lanes will be closed in both directions between Alameda Street and the San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605)

Monday, November 30 through Thursday, December 3

Eastbound I-10

- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to three lanes and the carpool lane from I-710 to I-605
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Carpool lane from Alameda Street to I-710
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Mission Road on-ramp, Cesar Chavez/Pleasant Avenue on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – State Street on-ramp, City Terrace off-ramp,
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Morengo Street/Soto Street on-ramp
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Connectors from north- and southbound I-5
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Connectors from north- and southbound I-710

Westbound I-10

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to four lanes and the carpool lane from I-605 to I-710
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Carpool lane from I-710 to Alameda Street
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Del Mar Avenue off-ramp

I-10 is a major thoroughfare serving commuters and large commercial vehicles. As a result of heavy use, the asphalt pavement in the carpool lanes has experienced extensive wear. New pavement will improve safety.
