SAN BERNARDINO FREEWAY (I-10) RESTORATION LANE CLOSURES

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of I-10 for pavement work. One lane will remain open to traffic at all times; no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Closures are as follows, weather permitting.

I-10

- 10 p.m. Friday, February 5 through 5 a.m. Monday, February 8 – The High occupancy vehicle (HOV or carpool) lanes will be closed in both directions between Alameda Street and the Long Beach Freeway (I-710).

- 7 p.m. to 11 a.m. – Up to four lanes and the carpool lane from I-5 to I-605
- 7 p.m. to 11 p.m. – Eastern Avenue, Fremont Avenue and Flair Drive on- and off-ramps
- 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. – Mission Road, Cesar Chavez/Pleasant Avenue, State Street, Marengo/Soto Street and Rosemead Boulevard on-ramps

Westbound I-10

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to three lanes and the carpool lane from Baldwin Avenue to I-710
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Carpool lane from I-710 to Alameda Street
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Del Mar Avenue carpool lane on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Del Mar Avenue on-ramp

I-10 is a major thoroughfare serving commuters and large commercial vehicles. As a result of heavy use, the asphalt pavement in the carpool lanes has experienced extensive wear. New pavement will improve safety and mobility for motorists. Atkinson Construction is the contractor on this \$165 million project which is expected to complete spring 2011. Caltrans advises motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”
