## **SAN BERNARDINO FREEWAY (I-10) RESTORATION LANE CLOSURES**

**LOS ANGELES** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of I-10 for pavement work. One lane will remain open to traffic at all times; no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Closures are as follows, weather permitting.

### **Tuesday, February 16 through Thursday, February 18**

#### **Eastbound I-10**

- 7 p.m. to 8 a.m. – Up to three lanes and the carpool lane from I-5 to I-605
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Carpool lane from Alameda Street to I-710
- 7 p.m. to Noon – Peck Road, Flair Drive, Rosemead, Del Mar Avenue, New Avenue, Garfield Avenue, Atlantic Boulevard, Fremont Avenue, Eastern Avenue
- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – City Terrace Drive off-ramp
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Valley Boulevard, Mission Road, Cesar Chavez/Pleasant Avenue, State Street and Marengo/Soto Street on-ramps
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Connectors from north- and southbound I-101
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Connectors from north- and southbound I-5
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Connectors from north- and southbound I-710
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Connectors to north- and southbound I-710

#### **Westbound I-10**

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to three lanes and the carpool lane from Baldwin Avenue to I-710
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Carpool lane from I-710 to Alameda Street
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Del Mar Avenue carpool lane on-ramp
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Peck Road off-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Del Mar Avenue on-ramp
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Connector to north- and southbound I-5

I-10 is a major thoroughfare serving commuters and large commercial vehicles. As a result of heavy use, the asphalt pavement in the carpool lanes has experienced extensive wear. New pavement will improve safety and mobility for motorists. Atkinson Construction is the contractor on this \$165 million project which is expected to complete spring 2011. Caltrans advises motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”
