SAN BERNARDINO FREEWAY (I-10) CLOSURES FOR RESTORATION

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close lanes and ramps for mainline, HOV (high occupancy vehicle or carpool) lane and ramp restoration on the San Bernardino Freeway (I-10), from the Golden State Freeway (I-5) to the San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605). One lane will remain open to traffic at all times; no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. The following schedule will be in effect, weather permitting:

Friday, April 24

Eastbound I-10

- 23:59 p.m. to 9 a.m. – Up to three lanes from I-710 to Garfield Avenue
- 7 p.m. to Noon – On- and off-ramps at Atlantic Boulevard and Garfield Avenue
- 7 p.m. to 8 a.m. – Connectors from north- and southbound I-710

Westbound I-10

- 9 p.m. to 8 a.m. – On-ramp at Del Mar Avenue

Saturday, April 25

Eastbound I-10

- 7 p.m. to 10 a.m. – Up to three lanes from I-710 to Garfield Avenue
- 5 p.m. to Noon – On- and off-ramps at Atlantic Boulevard and Garfield Avenue
- 7 p.m. to Noon – Connectors from north- and southbound I-710

Westbound I-10

- 9 p.m. to 10 a.m. – On-ramp at Del Mar Avenue

Monday, April 27

Westbound I-10

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to two lanes from New Avenue to I-710
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – On- and off-ramps at New Avenue, Atlantic Boulevard, Garfield Avenue, Fremont Avenue
- 9 p.m. to 10 a.m. – On-ramp at Del Mar Avenue

SAN BERNARDINO (I-10) LANE CLOSURE SCHEDULE

Tuesday, April 28 through Thursday April 30

Eastbound I-10

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to three lanes from I-710 to I-605
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – On- and off-ramps at New Avenue, Del Mar Avenue, San Gabriel Boulevard, Walnut Grove, Rosemead Boulevard, Flair Drive, and Baldwin Avenue

Westbound I-10

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – On-ramp at Del Mar Avenue

I-10 is a major thoroughfare serving commuters and large commercial vehicles. As a result of heavy use, the asphalt pavement in the carpool lanes has experienced extensive wear. New pavement will improve safety and mobility for motorists. Atkinson Construction is the contractor on this \$165 million project which is expected to complete spring 2011.
