## **SAN BERNARDINO FREEWAY (I-10) CLOSURES FOR RESTORATION**

**LOS ANGELES** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close lanes and ramps for mainline, HOV (high occupancy vehicle or carpool) lane and ramp restoration on the San Bernardino Freeway (I-10), from the Golden State Freeway (I-5) to the San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605). One lane will remain open to traffic at all times; no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. The following schedule will be in effect, weather permitting.

### **Tuesday, September 3 through Thursday, September 10**

#### **Eastbound I-10**

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to three lanes and the carpool lane from I-710 to I-605
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Carpool lane from Alameda Street to I-710
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – On- and off-ramps at Rosemead Boulevard, Flair Drive, Baldwin Avenue, Santa Anita Avenue
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Off-ramp at Peck Road
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – On-ramps at Valley Boulevard, Stewart Street, and Garvey Avenue/Durfee Avenue
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – North- and southbound I-710 connectors to eastbound I-10
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Eastbound I-10 connectors to north- and southbound I-605

#### **Westbound I-10**

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to four lanes and the carpool lane I-605 to I-710
- 10 p.m. to 10 a.m. – Carpool lane from I-710 to Alameda Street
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – On-ramp at Del Mar Avenue to the carpool lane
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – On- and off-ramps at Peck Road, Valley Boulevard and Santa Anita Avenue
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Off-ramp at Durfee Avenue/Garvey Avenue
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – On-ramp at Frazier Street/Bess Avenue
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – North- and southbound I-605 to westbound I-10

I-10 is a major thoroughfare serving commuters and large commercial vehicles. As a result of heavy use, the asphalt pavement in the carpool lanes has experienced extensive wear. New pavement will improve safety and mobility for motorists. Atkinson Construction is the contractor on this \$165 million project which is expected to complete spring 2011. Caltrans advises motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”

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
