SAN BERNARDINO FREEWAY (I-10) RESTORATION LANE CLOSURES

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of I-10 for pavement work. One lane will remain open to traffic at all times; no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Closures are as follows, weather permitting.

I-10

- 10 p.m. Friday, November 13 through 5 a.m. Monday, November 16 – The High occupancy vehicle (HOV or carpool) lanes will be closed in both directions between Alameda Street and the San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605)

Friday, November 20

Eastbound I-10

- 7 p.m. to 11 a.m. – Up to three lanes and the carpool lane from I-5 to I-605
- 10 p.m. to Noon – Carpool lane from Alameda Street to I-710
- 7 p.m. to 10 p.m. – Eastern Avenue, Flair Drive, Baldwin Avenue, Santa Anita Avenue and Peck Road on- and off-ramps
- 7 p.m. to 11 p.m. – Mission Boulevard, Cesar Chavez/Pleasant Avenue, State Street, Marengo/Soto Street, Valley Boulevard, Stewart Street and Garvey/Durfee Avenue on-ramps
- 9 p.m. to 10 p.m. – City Terrace Drive off-ramp
- 10 p.m. to 10 a.m. – Connectors from north- and southbound I-710

Westbound I-10

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to four lanes and the carpool lane from I-605 to I-710
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Carpool lane from I-710 to Alameda Street
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Peck Road, Valley Boulevard and Santa Anita Avenue on- and off-ramps
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Durfee/Garvey Avenue off-ramps
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Frazier Street/Bess Avenue and Del Mar Avenue on-ramps
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Connectors from north- and southbound I-605

I-10 is a major thoroughfare serving commuters and large commercial vehicles. As a result of heavy use, the asphalt pavement in the carpool lanes has experienced extensive wear. New pavement will improve safety and mobility for motorists. Atkinson Construction is the contractor on this \$165 million project which is expected to complete spring 2011. Caltrans advises motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”

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
