SAN BERNARDINO FREEWAY (I-10) CLOSURES FOR RESTORATION

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close lanes and ramps for mainline, HOV (high occupancy vehicle or carpool) lane and ramp restoration on the San Bernardino Freeway (I-10), from the Golden State Freeway (I-5) to the San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605). One lane will remain open to traffic at all times; no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. The following schedule will be in effect, weather permitting:

Monday, February 16 through Wednesday, February 18

Eastbound I-10

- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to two lanes from I-5 to Rosemead Boulevard I-605
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to two lanes from Rosemead Boulevard to I-605
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – HOV lanes from Alameda Street to I-710
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Southbound I-710 connector

Wednesday, February 18

Eastbound I-10

- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to two lanes from I-5 to Rosemead Boulevard I-605
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to two lanes from Rosemead Boulevard to I-605
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – On- and off-ramps at Fremont Avenue, Atlantic Boulevard, Garfield Avenue, New Avenue, Del Mar Avenue, San Gabriel Boulevard, Walnut Avenue, Rosemead Boulevard, Flair Drive, Temple City Boulevard and Baldwin Avenue
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Southbound I-710 connector

I-10 is a major thoroughfare connecting with downtown Los Angeles. As a result of heavy use, the asphalt pavement in the carpool lanes has experienced extensive wear. New pavement will improve safety and mobility for motorists. Atkinson Construction is the contractor on this \$165 million project which is expected to complete spring 2011. Caltrans advises motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”
