SAN BERNARDINO FREEWAY (I-10) LANE CLOSURES FOR PAVEMENT RESTORATION

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces a closure of the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV or carpool) lanes in both directions of the San Bernardino Freeway (I-10) from Alameda Street to the Long Beach Freeway (I-710) beginning Friday, October 2 at 10 p.m. until Monday, October 5, at 5 a.m. The mainline will remain open at all times.

As part of a pavement restoration project, a series of up to 40 extended weekend closures are planned through project completion in fall 2009. New pavement will improve safety and mobility for motorists. Griffith Company is the contractor on this \$18 million project. Caltrans advises motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”
