Glenn Anderson Freeway (I-105) Closures

LOS ANGELES – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Glenn Anderson Freeway (I-105) in the Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) area as part of two projects to widen and resurface the Sepulveda Boulevard on- and off-ramps. Closures are subject to change.

Eastbound I-105

Nightly, Monday, September 29, through Thursday, October 2:

- 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. – southbound Sepulveda Boulevard on-ramp.

Friday Night, October 3:

- Midnight to 9 a.m. – southbound Sepulveda Boulevard on-ramp.

Saturday Night, October 4:

- 10 p.m. to 10 a.m. – southbound Sepulveda Boulevard on-ramp.

Westbound I-105

Nightly, Monday, September 29, through Friday, October 3:

- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Northbound Sepulveda Boulevard off-ramp.

Daily, Monday, September 29, through Friday, October 3:

- 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. – southbound Sepulveda Boulevard on-ramp at Imperial Highway.

Nightly, Monday, September 29, through Thursday, October 2:

- 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. – southbound Sepulveda Boulevard on-ramp.

Friday Night, October 3:

- 11 p.m. to 10 a.m. – southbound Sepulveda Boulevard on-ramp at Imperial Highway.

Saturday Night, October 4:

- 9 p.m. to 11 a.m. – southbound Sepulveda Boulevard on-ramp at Imperial Highway.
