GLENN ANDERSON FREEWAY CLOSURE

LOS ANGELES – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the westbound Glenn Anderson Freeway (I-105) nightly for striping and installation of overhead signs. Closures are weather permitting and subject to change.

Nightly, Monday, February 1 through Thursday February 4:

- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – northbound Sepulveda off-ramp.
- 11:39 p.m. to 4 a.m. – FULL FREEWAY CLOSURE from Nash Street to Sepulveda Boulevard.

Friday Night, February 5:

- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – northbound Sepulveda off-ramp.
- 11:39 p.m. to 5 a.m. – FULL FREEWAY CLOSURE from Nash Street to Sepulveda Boulevard.

The second construction phase will provide two lanes and a standard safety shoulder for the Sepulveda Boulevard off-ramp. Estimated completion is spring 2010. Beador Construction Company is the contractor on this \$10 million project.

A detour will be posted for convenience.
