SR-134 – NEW HOLLYWOOD WAY ON-RAMP – UPDATE #6

VENTURA FREEWAY (SR-134) AT ALAMEDA – OVERNIGHT, TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WESTBOUND ON-RAMP, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY, OCTOBER 12-25

Burbank – As part of construction of a new on-ramp to the westbound Ventura Freeway (State Route 134) at Hollywood Way and Alameda Streets, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces the following, overnight temporary, intermittent westbound ramp closure:

- **The existing Alameda Avenue on-ramp to westbound State Route 134 will be closed nightly, intermittently, Monday through Friday from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. beginning Friday, October 12 through Thursday, October 25.**

A detour to an alternate on-ramp to westbound State Route 134 at Cahuenga Boulevard will be posted. An additional alternate on-ramp to westbound State Route 134 is also available at Buena Vista Street.

Caltrans thanks the motoring public and residents of Burbank, Toluca Lake and North Hollywood for their patience and cooperation during these transportation improvement projects. This freeway improvement project will enhance safety, relieve congestion and improve mobility and access to and from SR-134 and the Media District.
