### Ventura Freeway (SR-134) – New Hollywood On-Ramp Construction Update

**BURBANK** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close the Pass Avenue overcrossing (bridge) for construction of the new Hollywood Way on-ramp to westbound SR-134. This closure will begin fall 2009 and work is expected to complete spring 2010. The following detours will assist motorists and pedestrians:

#### Driving detours on Pass Avenue

##### Detour for Southbound Pass Avenue (North of Route 134):

1. On eastbound Verdugo Avenue
2. To southbound (right) Hollywood Way
3. To westbound (right) Alameda Avenue
4. End at Pass Avenue

##### Detour for northbound Pass Avenue (south of SR-134):

1. On eastbound Alameda Avenue
2. To northbound (left) Hollywood Way
3. To westbound (left) Verdugo Avenue
4. End at Pass Ave

#### Pedestrian detours on Pass Avenue are as follows:

##### North of SR-134:

1. Detour going east on Heffron Drive
2. Next go south on Hollywood Way
3. Next go west on Alameda Avenue
4. End on Pass Avenue

##### South of SR-134:

1. Detour going east on Alameda Avenue
2. Next go north on Hollywood Way
3. Next go west on Heffron Drive
4. End detour on Pass Avenue



## NEWS RELEASE

This freeway improvement project will enhance safety, relieve congestion, and improve mobility and access to and from SR-134 and the Media District. The new on-ramp is expected to complete summer 2010. The estimated cost is \$47 million.
