SR-134 – NEW HOLLYWOOD WAY ON-RAMP – UPDATE #7

TEMPORARY SIGNAL SHUTDOWN 12/18 – 12/20

Burbank – As part of construction of a new on-ramp to the westbound Ventura Freeway (State Route 134) at Hollywood Way and Alameda Streets, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces the following signal shutdowns. These signal shutdowns are necessary in order to install new traffic signals and lighting poles:

- **Tuesday, December 18 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. : Signal shutdown at Alameda Street and Pass Avenue**
- **Tuesday, December 18 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.: Signal shutdown at Alameda Street and westbound State Route 134 off-ramp at Hollywood Way (near Cordova Street)**
- **Wednesday, December 19 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.: Signal shutdown at Alameda Street and westbound State Route 134 off-ramp at Hollywood Way (near Cordova Street).**
- **Thursday, December 20 from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.: Signal shutdown at Alameda Street and westbound State Route 134 off-ramp at Hollywood Way (near Cordova Street).**

These closures are weather-permitting and subject to change.

Law enforcement personnel will be on site to assist with traffic control. Caltrans thanks the motoring public and residents of Burbank, Toluca Lake and North Hollywood for their patience and cooperation during these transportation improvement projects. This freeway improvement project will enhance safety, relieve congestion and improve mobility and access to and from SR-134 and the Media District.
