CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), for pavement work. The closures are as follows:

NORTHBOUND I-5

Sunday, Night, March 1:

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to three lanes northbound I-5 between SR-110 to SR-2

Nightly, Monday, March 2, Tuesday, March 3 and Thursday, March 5:

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes northbound I-5 between SR-2 to SR-134

Nightly, Wednesday, March 4 through Thursday, March 5

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – All connectors from northbound I-5 to SR-2
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to three lanes from southbound SR-110 to eastbound I-10
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Broadway on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Los Feliz Boulevard on ramp
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Glendale Boulevard on ramp
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Stadium Way on- and off ramps

SOUTHBOUND I-5

Saturday, Night, March 7:

- 11:59 p.m. to 10a.m. – Up to three lanes from SR-110 to SR-2
- 10 p.m. to 11 a.m. – Broadway Boulevard on-ramp
- 11:59 p.m. to 10 a.m. – All connectors from southbound I-5 to eastbound I-10

Sunday, Night, March 8:

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to three lanes from southbound SR-110 to eastbound I-10
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Broadway Boulevard on-ramp

SOUTHBOUND SR-110

Daily, Saturday, March 7:

- 1 a.m. to 10 a.m. – Up to three lanes from southbound SR-110 to eastbound I-10

The closures are in connection with the \$56 million pavement rehabilitation project on the I-5. FCI Constructors, Inc. is the contractor. Estimated completion date is winter 2010/2011. This project will replace damaged cement slab and grind or overlay the existing pavement in order to provide additional skid resistance and increase public safety.
