CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), for pavement work. The closures are as follows:

NORTHBOUND I-5

Nightly, Monday, June 9 through Wednesday, June 11:

- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to four lanes from the I-10 connector to the SR-110 connectors
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Marengo Road on-ramp
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – State Street on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Northbound I-5 connector to eastbound I-10.

Thursday, Night, June 12

- 11:59 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to three lanes from the SR-110 connector to the SR-2 connectors
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Riverside Drive on-ramp
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Broadway Boulevard on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Northbound I-5 connector to eastbound I-10

Friday, Night, June 13

- 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. – Marengo Road on-ramp
- 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. – State Street on-ramp

WESTBOUND I-10

Nightly, Monday, June 9 through Wednesday, June 11:

- 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Westbound SR- 110 connector to northbound I-5.

Nightly, Friday, June 13 and Saturday, June 14

- 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Westbound SR- 10 connector to northbound I-5.

NORTHBOUND SR-110

Thursday, Night, June 12

- 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. – North-Southbound SR-110 to northbound I-5

Saturday, Night, June 14

- 7 p.m. to 12 a.m. – North-Southbound SR-110 to northbound I-5

FCI Constructors, Incorporated is the contractor on this \$56 million pavement rehabilitation project which will replace damaged cement slabs, grind or overlay the existing pavement to provide additional skid resistance and increase public safety.
