CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), for pavement work. The closures are as follows:

NORTHBOUND I-5

Nightly, Thursday, July 24 through Monday, July 28:

- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to four lanes from the I-10 connector to the SR-110 connector
- 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. – Cesar Chavez off-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – State Street on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. – Fourth Street on- and off ramps
- 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. – Santa Fe on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. – Northbound I-5 connector to eastbound I-10.

WESTBOUND SR-60

Nightly, Friday, July 25 and Saturday, July 26:

- 8 p.m. to 11 a.m. – Westbound SR-60 connector to northbound I-5.

FCI Constructors, Incorporated is the contractor on this \$56 million pavement rehabilitation project which will replace damaged cement slabs, grind or overlay the existing pavement to provide additional skid resistance and increase public safety. Estimated completion is winter 2010/2011. Caltrans reminds motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”
