CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), for pavement work. The closures are as follows:

SOUTHBOUND I-5

Nightly, Monday, August 31 through Thursday, September 3:

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to 3 lanes from the eastbound I-10 connect to Soto Street
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Mission Road on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Cesar Chavez on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Fourth Street on- and off-ramps

NORTHBOUND I-5

Nightly, Monday, August 31 through Thursday, September 3:

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – all connectors from SR-110 to I-5
- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Marengo Street on ramp

WESTBOUND I-10

Monday, Night, August 31:

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – All connectors from I-10 to southbound I-5

The closures are in connection with the \$56 million pavement rehabilitation project on the I-5. FCI Constructors, Inc. is the contractor. Estimated completion date is winter 2010/2011. This project will replace damaged cement slab and grind or overlay the existing pavement in order to provide additional skid resistance and increase public safety.
