**LOS ANGELES** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), for pavement work. The closures are as follows:

## **NORTH- and SOUTHBOUND SR-2**

**Nightly, Monday, October 19 through Thursday, October 22:**

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – all connectors to southbound I-5

The closures are in connection with the \$56 million pavement rehabilitation project on the I-5. FCI Constructors, Inc. is the contractor. Estimated completion date is winter 2010/2011. This project will replace damaged cement slab and grind or overlay the existing pavement in order to provide additional skid resistance and increase public safety.
