CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), for pavement work. The closures are as follows:

SOUTH- NORTHBOUND I-5

Nightly, Tuesday, November 17 through Thursday, November 19:

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to 2 lanes from SR-110 to I-10
- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to 2 lanes from SR-134 to SR-2
- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to 2 lanes from SR-2 to SR-110
- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to 2 lanes from Whiter Boulevard to I-10

The closures are in connection with the \$56 million pavement rehabilitation project on the I-5. FCI Constructors, Inc. is the contractor. Estimated completion date is winter 2010/2011. This project will replace damaged cement slab and grind or overlay the existing pavement in order to provide additional skid resistance and increase public safety.
