CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), for pavement work. The closures are as follows:

NORTHBOUND I-5

Nightly, Sunday, June 14 through Thursday, June 18:

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to 4 lanes between SR-110 to and SR-2

Thursday, Night, June 18:

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Riverside Drive on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – connectors from I-5 to and SR-110
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Pasadena Boulevard on-ramp

SOUTHBOUND I-5

Night, Sunday, June 14 through Wednesday, June 17:

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Mission Road off-ramp
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Broadway Boulevard on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to 3 lanes between SR-110 and I-10

NORTH- and SOUTHBOUND SR-110

Thursday, Night, June 18:

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – All connectors from north- and southbound I-5

The closures are in connection with the \$56 million pavement rehabilitation project on the I-5. FCI Constructors, Inc. is the contractor. Estimated completion date is winter 2010/2011. This project will replace damaged cement slab and grind or overlay the existing pavement in order to provide additional skid resistance and increase public safety.
