I-405 FULL FREEWAY CLOSURES SCHEDULED

LOS ANGELES – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close all lanes of the southbound San Diego Freeway (I-405) on Thursday, August 21, 12:01 a.m. to 4 a.m., from Santa Monica Boulevard to I-10 connector.

Detours will be posted.

The closure, to install underground sensors, is connected to the \$50 million project to extend the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV, or carpool) lane on southbound I-405 from Sunset Boulevard to the Santa Monica Freeway (I-10).

The project, completing this summer, is one of several improvement projects underway on I-405 in Los Angeles County. By early 2009, when all are completed, there will be a continuous HOV lane on southbound I-405 from the San Fernando Valley to Orange County.
