UPDATE - PACIFIC COAST HIGHWAY LANE CLOSURE

MALIBU – The California Department of Transportation closed one lane of northbound Pacific Coast Highway (Route 1) between Corral Canyon Road and Latigo Canyon Road on Monday, February 25 for approximately four weeks.

The closure will enable rock removal due to a slide caused by recent storms.

“**Reduced Speed Zone Ahead**” signs are posted for northbound traffic approaching and traveling through the closure.

“**Share the Road**” signs are posted to notify motorists to accommodate cyclists and to ensure bicycle safety through the construction zone. Flagmen will be stationed to caution motorists traveling behind cyclists in the single lane portion of the closure.

Emergency slope repair work is continuing just north of Trancas Canyon Road and south of Kanan Road. The work is scheduled to be completed in approximately 2 weeks at which time the k-rail will be removed. The shoulder will be repaved during the construction period. During the construction period, "Share the Road" signs will be posted within the project limits at both locations.

Motorists are encouraged to drive with caution through the work zone. Remember to “Slow for the Cone Zone”.
