## **I-210 Closures in San Fernando Valley Scheduled for Pavement Rehabilitation**

**Los Angeles** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Foothill Freeway (I-210) as part of a pavement rehabilitation project. Consecutive ramps will not be closed at the same time. Detour signs will be posted. The following schedule will be in effect, weather permitting, and is subject to change:

**Tuesday, February 16 through Thursday, February 18**

### **Eastbound I-210**

- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – Lowell Avenue off-ramp, La Tuna Canyon Road on- and off-ramps
- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – Up to 2 lanes between Wheatland Avenue and Pennsylvania Avenue
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to 3 lanes between Wheatland Avenue and Pennsylvania Avenue
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Lowell Avenue and La Tuna Canyon Road on- and off-ramps

### **Westbound I-210**

- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – Lowell Avenue on-ramp, La Tuna Canyon Road on- and off-ramps
- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – Up to 2 lanes between Pennsylvania Avenue and Wheatland Avenue
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to 3 lanes between Pennsylvania Avenue and Wheatland Avenue
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Lowell Avenue, La Tuna Canyon Road on- and off-ramps

Security Paving Company, Inc. is the contractor on this \$67.2 million project, which is anticipated to complete fall, 2016.
