Long Beach Freeway (I-710) Lane and Ramp Closures

LONG BEACH - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the northbound and southbound Long Beach Freeway (I-710) for asphalt concrete grinding and paving between Anaheim Street and Pacific Coast Highway (PCH)/State Route 1 (SR-1).

The following schedule will be in effect:

Overnight, Monday, April 7

Northbound

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. - **Full closure** of northbound I-710 from Shoreline Drive to PCH (SR-1).
- 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. - northbound I-710 on-ramp at Pico Avenue.
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. - northbound I-710 on-ramp at Shoreline Drive.
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. - northbound I-710 on-ramp at East Anaheim Street.
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. - northbound I-710 on-ramp and off-ramp at West Anaheim Street.

Overnight, Tuesday, April 8

Southbound

- Midnight to 4 a.m. - **Full closure** of southbound I-710 from PCH (SR-1) to Anaheim Street.
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. - southbound I-710 on-ramp from northbound PCH (SR-1).
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. - southbound I-710 on-ramp from southbound PCH (SR-1).

All American Asphalt is the contractor on this \$5.6 million project, which is estimated to complete in early summer, nearly five months ahead of schedule. The benefits of this pavement improvement project are a smoother driving surface and an extended life span of the road.

For the safety of motorists and freeway work crews, Caltrans reminds the public to please "Slow for the Cone Zone."

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
