SANTA MONICA FREEWAY (I-10) AND HARBOR FREEWAY (I-110) CLOSURES

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of I-10 and I-110 freeways as part of a pavement rehabilitation project. The closures are as follows:

Westbound I-10

Nightly, Tuesday, July 29 through Thursday, July 31

- 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to three lanes from the Hollywood Freeway (US 101) to I-110
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Maple Street on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Grand Avenue on-ramp
- 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Alameda Street off-ramp
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Santa Fe Avenue on- and off-ramps
- 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Mateo Street off-ramp
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – North- and southbound I-110 connectors
- 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to two lanes on the westbound State Route 60 (SR-60)

Eastbound I-10

Nightly, Tuesday, July 29 through Thursday, July 31

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes and the carpool lane from US 101 to I-110
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Flower Street on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Grand Avenue off-ramp
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Maple Avenue off-ramp
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Los Angeles Street off-ramp
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – San Pedro Street on- and off-ramps
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Alameda Street on- and off-ramps

- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Eastbound I-10 collector road from Hoover Street to Flower Street

Wednesday Night, July 30

- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Eastbound I-10 collector road from Alameda Street to eastbound SR 60/northbound I-5

Northbound I-110

Nightly, Tuesday, July 29 through Thursday, July 31

- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – East- and westbound I-10 connector

Southbound I-110

Nightly, Tuesday, July 29 through Thursday, July 31

- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Washington Boulevard on-ramp

Westbound SR-60

Nightly, Tuesday, July 29 through Thursday, July 31

- 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Santa Fe Avenue/Mateo Street off-ramp
