INSTALLATION OF STORM DRAIN DEVICES SCHEDULED

Long Beach/Lynwood – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Gardena Freeway (SR-91) and the Glenn Anderson Freeway (I-105) to install devices to prevent debris from entering storm drains. The following closures will be in effect weather permitting:

EASTBOUND SR-91

Daily, Monday, February 11, through Thursday, February 14:

- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – Alameda Street off-ramp
- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – Long Beach Boulevard off-ramp

Nightly, Sunday, February 10, through Thursday, February 14:

- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Alameda Street off-ramp
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Long Beach Boulevard off-ramp
- 11:59 p.m. to 6 a.m. – One lane from Alameda Street to Long Beach Boulevard

EASTBOUND I-105

Nightly, Sunday, February 10, through Thursday, February 14:

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Eastbound I-105 connector to the northbound I-710
- 6 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Long Beach Boulevard on-ramp
- 11:59 p.m. to 5 a.m. – One lane from Long Beach Boulevard to Atlantic Boulevard

WESTBOUND I-105

Daily, Monday, February 11, through Thursday 14:

- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – Northbound I-710 connector to the westbound I-105
- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – Central Avenue off-ramp

Nightly, Sunday, February 10, through Thursday, February 14:

- 7 p.m. to 6 p.m. – Central Avenue on-and-off-ramps
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Northbound I-710 Connector to the westbound I-105
- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Long Beach Boulevard off-ramp
- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – One lane from Atlantic Boulevard to Long Beach Boulevard

INSTALLATION OF STORM DRAIN DEVICES

This \$8.8 million project will install Gross Solid Removal Devices (GSRDs) in compliance with the Federal Clean Water Act (CWA) and the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Los Angeles Region (LARWQCB). GSRDs will be installed on storm drains along portions of four freeways including the Santa Monica Freeway (I-10), the Harbor Freeway (I-110), the Glenn Anderson Freeway (I-105) and the Gardena Freeway (SR- 91). Estimated completion is winter 2009.
